Homicide

July 16, 2009

On June 5, 2009, at approximately 9:20 p.m., deputies from the San Xavier District responded to the 2600 blk. of W. Quail Road in reference to an unknown problem. Upon arrival, deputies found a male victim who had been shot several times. The victim was transported to a local hospital in critical condition.

The Robbery/Assault Unit responded to further investigate. The victims, a father and his adult son, were in their front yard when three male subjects approached them. The suspects ordered the victims to the ground at which time the father was shot. The suspects fled from the scene before deputies arrived.

On July 14, 2009, the victim identified as the father, Luis Alfonso Flores (DOB 10/23/57), succumbed to his injuries.

The death has been classified as a homicide. The Pima County Sheriff's Homicide Unit detectives will continue to move forward with the case. At the time of the incident, one of the suspects was located and charged with Aggravated Assault. Those charges were dismissed by the Pima County Attorney's Office pending further investigation. At this time, no motive has been established and there have been no arrests. As updates are received, there may be additional information released.
